

STREETS MAINTENANCE WORKER

JOB DESCRIPTION

Maintains streets and roadways including repairing, grading, maintaining signs, striping and other related tasks. Performs maintenance and repairs of streets, curbs, road shoulders, curbs, and ditches and drainage to required specifications. Prepares and applies pesticides and other chemicals as required for maintenance of affected areas. Operates trucks, tractors, and any other equipment or vehicles required to accomplish the duties of the position.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

In addition to the duties outlined above, employee is required to work and assist in the other areas of Public Works on a regular basis. This includes Parks Maintenance, Stormwater, Utility Plant and System Maintenance (Water, Wastewater, Electric), and Sanitation to include monthly meter reading. There are many other seasonal duties and projects that employee will be required to work and assist. There will be periods that will require stand-by time and mandatory overtime to ensure the continued safe and effective operations of the City. This list is not all inclusive of duties that may be required.

QUALIFICATIONS

Sufficient experience and education to understand verbal and written directions from supervisor and written instructions handling pesticides. Previous verifiable experiences with hand tools, power tools, operating vehicles and equipment are desired.

KNOWLEDGE/SKILL/ABILITY

Expected to possess demonstrated knowledge of and skill in safely using appropriate tools and equipment in performing the duties identified above or other similar experience. Abilities to perform heavy, manual labor, follow verbal and written directions, operate or learn to operate a variety of equipment, read and comprehend written material such as operation and maintenance manuals, prepare legible daily work tickets, practice safe work procedures and maintain effective working relationships with others are required.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Position requires sitting, standing, and walking on level and slippery surfaces. Also requires reaching, twisting, turning, kneeling, banding, stooping, squatting, and making repetitive hand movement in the performance of daily duties in addition to lifting objects weighing 80 pounds. The incumbent in this position works outdoors in all weather conditions and due to spraying is exposed to fumes, dust and air contaminants which may cause eye and skin irritation. The nature of the work also requires the incumbent to use power, noise and vibration producing tools and equipment, drive motorized vehicles and equipment and work in heavy vehicle conditions which subjects the employee to mechanical and electrical hazards.

OTHER DATA

Work Hours are 7:00 AM to 4 PM, Monday to Friday with 1 hour lunch. Must have a valid Class E Florida Driver's License

Salary is \$12.00 per hour with full benefits. Mandatory overtime may be required.
