

## RESOLUTION 2023-01

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MOORE HAVEN, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023, STATING THE PERCENT BY WHICH THE MILLAGE RATE LEVIED EXCEEDS THE ROLLED BACK RATE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Moore Haven, has advertised and held public hearings; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is being considered at a duly constituted meeting of the City Council of the City of Moore Haven;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Moore Haven, Florida by majority vote as follows:

1. The millage rate is set at 4.2500 per thousand dollars valuation on all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the said City, subject to taxation on the first day of January 1, 2023, provided however, that such shall not be levied upon that property claimed and allowed as homestead or as otherwise exempted under the Constitution or General Laws of the State of Florida for the 2022-2023 tax year.

2. The millage rate herein levied exceeds the rolled-back rate by 5.11% computed pursuant to Florida Statutes, Section 200.065. (1)

3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed and directed to certify to the Property Appraiser of Glades County, Florida, the above millage to be levied for all purposes for the 2022-2023 tax year, pursuant to the provision of the laws of the State of Florida.

4. This Resolution shall take effect October 1, 2022.

This Resolution was unanimously passed and adopted this 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 2022.
