

RESOLUTION NO. 2025 -01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY-COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING RATES TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION; PROVIDING FOR FILING OF A COPY OF RATES WITH AUTHORITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City-County Public Works Authority Board as follows:

1. After holding a properly advertised public hearing, the City-County Public Works Authority hereby adopts the Schedule of User Rates and Charges commencing upon adoption, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. The Schedule of User Rates and Charges shall supercede all schedules or amounts previously adopted.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

A. WASTEWATER RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES:

1. Base Facility Charges:

Single Family (individually metered dwelling units including mobile homes and RVs)

4. System Development Charge/Capacity Charge (per ERU)

5. Industrial Wastewater

To be determined on an individual basis by special agreement according to volume and characteristics of wastewater. Pretreatment to domestic standards shall be required.

6. High Strength Industrial Wastewater Surcharge

To be determined on an individual basis by special agreement according to volume and characteristics of wastewater. Pretreatment to domestic standards shall be required.

7. Residential Wastewater

To be paid at time of application for building permit filed with local government.

B. DEPOSITS FOR SERVICE (MINIMUM) AND MISCELLANEOUS

3. Install meter and reconnect sewer and turn water on for any customer after water was disconnected and meter removed. Same fees for new water and/or sewer service.
4. Reinstallation of service line after removed due to illegal turn on or tampering with service. Same fees for new water and/or sewer service.
5. Destruction of meter and/or related equipment. At replacement cost as determined by the City-County Public Works Authority.
6. Returned Check.
\$25.00 or five percent (5%) of the amount of the check, whichever is greater, plus other applicable fees in the event service is disconnected.
7. Recording of easements, annexation agreements, etc. \$10.00 per page, plus Administrative fee of \$10.00 per document.
8. System Development Charges/ Capacity Charge.
The estimated System Development Charges/Capacity Fee charge shall be based upon the estimated ERUs to be provided to any new development or expansion, must be paid prior to final connection to the City-County Public Works Authority's System.
9. Project plan review.
The City-County Public Works Authority will review all plans and specifications of all proposed extensions or developments. An owner or developer will pay a one-time fee of \$100.00 per ERU or as negotiated pursuant to a Utility Service Agreement. Project plans will not be approved until full payment of fee is received.
10. Project inspection.
All projects must be inspected by the City-County Public Works Authority and the owner or developer shall pay fees at the rate of \$25.00, due upon permit application.
11. Miscellaneous charges for services not included above.
Actual costs of material and labor required plus an administrative charge of fifteen percent (15%) or \$25.00, whichever is greater, to be determined by the City-County Public Works Authority.
12. Late Fees on delinquent accounts.
Ten percent (10%) per month on all delinquent amounts more than 10 days past due.

13. Suspension or termination of Potable Water and Sewer Services.

Any account for residential or non-residential services that is more than 20 days delinquent may be temporarily suspended, terminated or closed, including any potable water service being provided to the affected real property. In such case, potable water and sewer services shall not be reinstated until all delinquent fees or charges are fully paid including all late fees and reinstatement charges.
